Federal Communications Commission

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has created the National Do Not Call Registration, which will soon prohibit people or entities, including Chambers of Commerce and Associations, from sending you any communications by fax that contain promotional materials, without previously having received written consent from you. This prohibitionapplies even if the parties have a business relationship, such as exists between the Puerto Rico Chamber of Commerce (PRCC) and its members. Our fax mailings have been affected due to this new regulation of the FCC. The definition of Promotions Not Requested quite wide. It includes: any types of commercial promotions, quality, property, goods, and services. The FCC indicates that this definition includes conference reminders, seminars, membership renewals and new product announcements, among other things. Our Puerto Rico Chamber of Commerce will not be able to send you any faxes or emails that could contain promotions unless you provide us with a written consent, granting us permission to send you the aforementioned information.
