Hurricane Maria Lessons Learned

- Interagency coordination is critical and must be addressed in all plans
- Importance of proactive measures by US NORTHCOM to pre-position support elements
- Have Emergency Management Assistance Compacts (EMAC Agreements) in place









On-going Operations after Earthquakes

- Base Camp Management in Ponce, Peñuelas, Guayanilla, Yauco and Guanica
 - PRNG Medical Personnel Over 6,000 Health Care Services provided
 - PRNG Cooks Over 96,000 meals prepared
 - USAR Laundry & Bath Specialists Over 20,000 showers administered and over 3,900 bundles of laundry serviced
- Over 1.7 Million Bottles of Water and more than 100,000 MREs delivered
- Direct assistance with Safety Assessments, Security, and Mental/Spiritual Health









Importance of being Prepared

- Everyone must have a Family Plan
- Evacuation Plans at work and at home are needed
- Emergency Bags must be prepared with survival items as well as important documents and identification
