About Holberton Puerto Rico

- **Code Puerto Rico, LLC (d/b/a Holberton PR)**
 - Founders: Adam Beguelin & Cyril Meduña
- **The Problem - Human Talent**
 - Limited local tech-talent, especially Full-Stack Coders, needed to fuel a local Tech-Industry
- **Solution - Education**
 - Start a Coding School – Holberton Puerto Rico
 - Teach students to think and learn like the best programmers; helps students develop soft skills to get them noticed in interviews; a curriculum developed to give students practical experience

- Anti-plagiarism system


10% student-led (peer learning)

Software Curriculum

- 7 programs: 12 (3) or 18 (4) months
- Full-Time (40 hrs/wk)
- Part-Time (Tuesday/Thursday, 6-9pm; Saturday, 9am-6pm)
- Career Track
- Flexibility
- Peer-learning
- Career days



Tuition is free until students find a Job Income Share Agreement (ISA)

ISA removes the financial barriers to good quality education:

- **Free** until students find a job
- **No up-front** tuition required
- No student **debt** nor loan interest

ISA Aligns interest of school and student

- Holberton Puerto Rico succeeds **when students succeed**
- **Alleviate student burden** away from traditional college debt
