

Mr. José Domingo Pérez, P.E. is a former president of the General Contractors Association of Puerto Rico, of the Civil Engineers Institute, and of the Engineers and Surveyors Association of Puerto Rico.

Engineer Pérez is president and founder of Caribe Tecno, Inc., a construction firm that has developed and built nationally and internationally awarded projects, such as hospitals, stadiums, coliseums, tourist docks, urban train buildings, office and industrial buildings, extensive parks and urban spaces, dozens of educational facilities and thousands of individual and multi-family housing units.

In addition to being an engineer and surveyor, he supports the
