



Dr. Gonzalez-Feliciano accepted the position of Health Secretary, offered by the Governor of Puerto Rico and was confirmed by the Senate of Puerto Rico in September 2009.

One of his biggest challenges has been the implementation of the United States Health Reform in Puerto Rico and has worked extensively in obtaining federal and state funds to finance health services for those who do not have medical insurance or have insufficient medical insurance coverage in PR.

He obtained his Bachelor's Degree in Biology from the University of Puerto Rico in 1980. In 1984, he started studying General Medicine and in 1988, he entered the Albert Einstein Medicine of School in New York to specialize in Adult Psychiatry. In 1991, he sub-specialized in Children and Adolescents Psychiatry at the Columbia Presbyterian Hospital, New York.

Dr. González is certified in therapies with electro convulsions, completed his certification for the Practice of Acupuncture Procedures in the University of California, has an MBA from Pittsburgh University, a Ph.D. in Health Services Administration from Michigan Central University and has been a member of the "Joint Commission" of the Health Services Accreditation Agency. He is licensed to practice medicine in Puerto Rico, Florida, New York and Pennsylvania.
