

Estimated Distribution of Healthcare Resources in 2016






Healthcare Challenges – Today

- Comprehensive system (integrated care/patient centric, quality based, FWA, highly regulated, economic controls/constraints)
- 3. Doctors leaving PR






GDP Forecast 2018
