

A Black Swan, for the sake of this discussion, is thought to be a surprise event without precedent at the moment it occurred.



WE must make that PROMISE to each other!








#### United States Unemployment Rate by Race , 2004-2016














PR Health Care Delivery System – How it work\$

#### PMPM in Medicaid and Medicare Advantage, Puerto Rico: 2011-2018


